Sunday of the the Healing of the Blind Man. This man, who had been "born blind," encountered Jesus. The man was, apparently, begging for money or food at the gate of the Temple and when Jesus spoke to him he listened and was obedient to the Lord's command. Unlike the other figures in the Gospel account, this man alone had never seen the miraculous works of Christ, and yet, trusted in his word. We to, who have "not seen and yet believe" trust in the word of the Lord and follow in his ways. In this way, we, who were formerly blinded by sin, have begun to see through faith.

The conversion of Saul who, blinded by anger and his persecution of the Church, discovers that he is persecuting Christ himself and is called to join in the healing ministry of the Lord. We too, baptized into Christ and have received the vision of faith, are called to do "work[s] befitting [our] repentance." We are to bring healing to those who are spiritually blind and to help those to whom God has called us to minister "to open their eyes that they may turn from darkness to light, and from the dominion of Satan to God; that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those sanctified by faith in me."
